Affordable Artists Studios, envisioned as co-working spaces, are now available at the American Tin Cannery, 125 Oceanview Blvd., Ste 210. This has been made possible through the efforts of the Arts Council for Monterey County, in collaboration with Cannery Row Company, who own the site.

Soon the 8,000sf space on the second floor of the ATC will be filled with the works of up to 10 local artists. The space will be open to the public each Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Each artist will occupy from 100sf to 400sf of space in an open air, collaborative environment.

Katy Rankin-Read, of "Katy Did It" Designs, was among the first to jump on board and already has her unique cross-stitch works in the front window.

The Council's Deputy Director, Jacquie Atchison and Administrative Coordinator, Tina Stewart, are spearheading this project. "One of the biggest obstacles facing artists is affordable work space.
