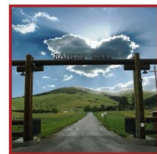

ArtWorks @Pacific Grove Third Friday Artwalk

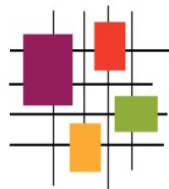
The mission of ArtWorks @Pacific Grove is to be a vibrant, cultural cooperative where Monterey County artists work, collaborate and contribute to the local community.
