Community Arts Grants are available to small and emerging organizations with budgets up to \$250,000, who are seeking support for public arts and culture projects/programs, with grants up to \$5,000 per year. No deadline – grants are reviewed on a monthly basis. Organizations may only receive one Community Arts Grant per year and must have completed their previous grant's final report before submitting a new application. 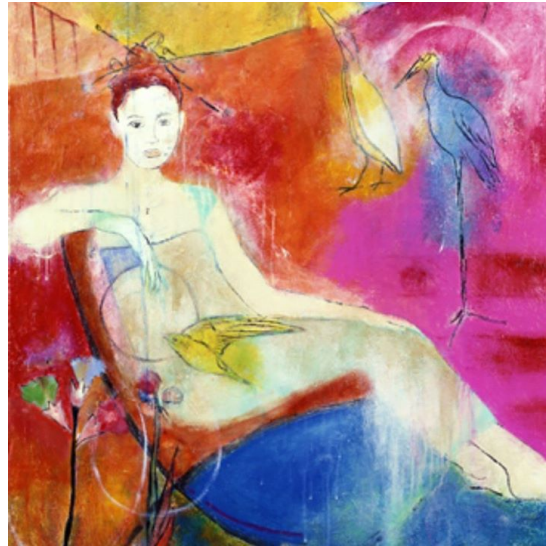
