ARTS COUNCIL FOR MONTEREY COUNTY ANNOUNCES NEW GRANT FUNDING!

[Seaside, CA. November 22, 2019] The Arts Council for Monterey County is pleased to announce additional funding to provide support to local arts and cultural organizations. Thanks to the David and Lucile Packard Foundation, the Arts Council is able to increase the applicant pool by inviting organizations with budgets up to \$250,000 to apply for grants up to \$5,000.

Community Arts Grants are available to Monterey County-based nonprofit organizations whose budgets are \$250,000 or less and are seeking support for public arts and culture projects/programs up to \$5,000 per year. There is no deadline and these grants are reviewed on a monthly basis.

Organizations may only receive one grant per year and must have completed their previous grant's final report before submitting a new application.

"We are thrilled to have this opportunity provide this funding to more organizations in the region", states Jacquie Atchison, Deputy Director for the Arts Council.
