Community Arts Grants are available to small and emerging organizations with budgets up to \$250,000, who are seeking support for public arts and culture projects/programs, with grants up to \$5,000 per year.

No deadline - grants are reviewed on a monthly basis until funds are expended.

Economic Impact Grants are available to small nonprofit arts organizations seeking general operating support who have or will have an economic loss from cancellations or closures due to the Coronavirus crisis. Maximum award size is \$5,000 based on the scoring of your application. Grants will be awarded on a first come, first served basis.

DEADLINE: UNTIL FUNDS ARE EXPENDED.


