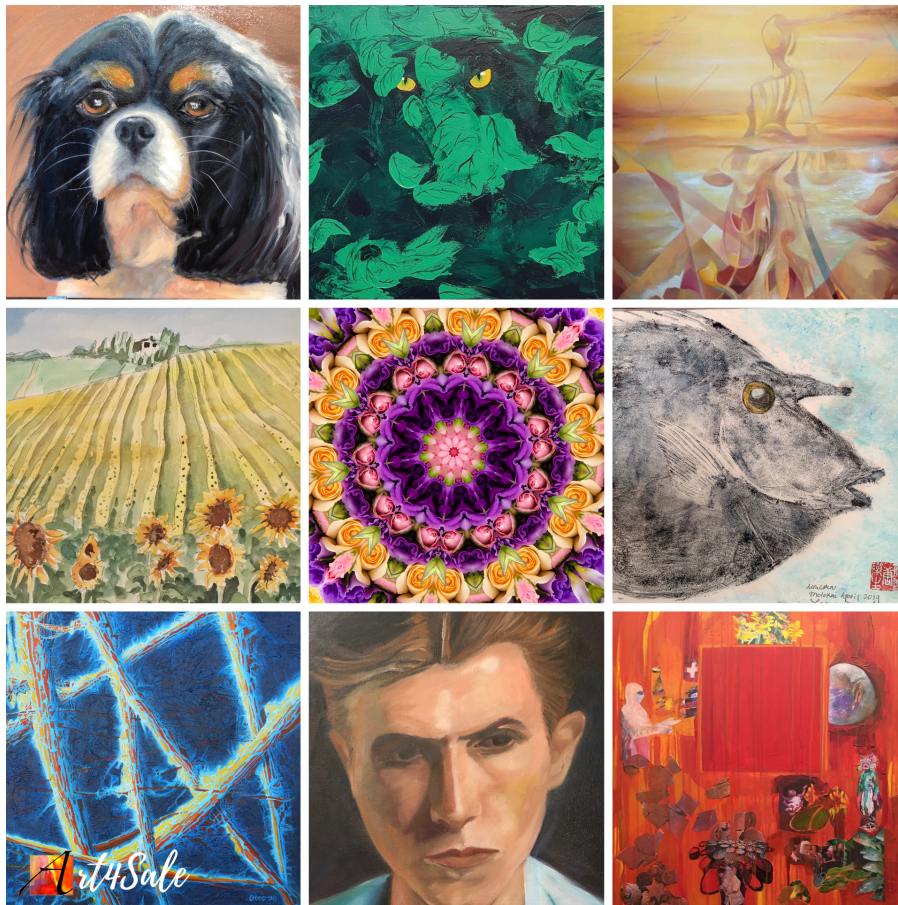

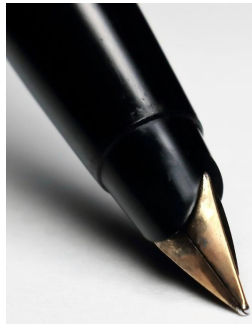
Get to know Artist Diane Grindol

She took some classes at the “Ecole des Beaux Arts” in Nantes, France and studied with a private watercolor instructor who helped her organize an exhibit of her work before she left there. In 1982 Diane moved to the Monterey Peninsula and spent 25 years doing no artwork. Diane signed up for an animal drawing class through Carmel Adult School around 2006. Slowly her confidence returned and being in the community of artists was inspiring. Now Diane teaches classes at Pacific Grove Adult Education.


YAC is currently accepting applications
