Arts Education is on the ballot this November!



The Arts and Music in Schools measure has officially qualified for the California ballot this November! The proposition, which would dedicate up to \$900 million a year in state funding to arts and music education in public schools, recently qualified for the November ballot.

California voters will have the opportunity to ensure all of the 6+ million PK-12 students in public schools have access to quality arts education without raising taxes. The bulk of the money would go to hiring teachers and aides, and in addition to traditional visual and performing arts, there would be instruction in computer graphics, animation and coding. **Vote yes this November!**
