We have exciting news to share! We are moving our offices to Monterey, off on Highway 68 - more accessible from Salinas and the Peninsula. Our current Seaside office will be converted to an "ArtWorks" to provide affordable studio space for emerging artists.



Be on the lookout next week as we launch a new grant opportunity for local nonprofits and artists to work together to develop a media, outreach and engagement initiative around (1) Public health awareness messages to stop the spread of COVID-19 (2) Climate Impact - public awareness related to water and energy conservation, climate mitigation, and emergency preparedness, relief, and recovery (3) Civic engagement, including election participation; and (4) Social justice and community engagement. Twenty three projects of \$140,000 each will be awarded in the following counties: Monterey, San Benito, Sa Luis Obispo, Santa Barbara, Santa Cruz and Ventura. *Visit <u>arts4mc.org</u> after March 6th for more information.*



- Transcript showing a 2.0 GPA or above


