OVER \$100,000 IN ARTS & CULTURAL GRANTS AWARDED TO LOCAL NONPROFITS

[Monterey, CA. December 12, 2023] The Arts Council for Monterey County (Arts4MC) is thrilled to announce they have awarded \$109,000 in Arts & Cultural Impact Grants to 22 local arts organizations and nonprofit organizations with art programs thanks to the funding from the County of Monterey and the Board of Supervisors.

This is the first round of Arts & Cultural Impact grants to be awarded this fiscal year with the second round to be awarded in the Spring. "I am happy to say that each organization that applied, was awarded a grant," said Jacquie Atchison, Executive Director of Arts4MC, "We would love to see more organizations apply, particularly from groups who haven't applied before."

Arts & Cultural Impact Grants are available to nonprofit organizations seeking support for public arts and culture projects/programs. The next funding cycle will be open in the Spring and more information can be found at arts4mc.org/grants.
