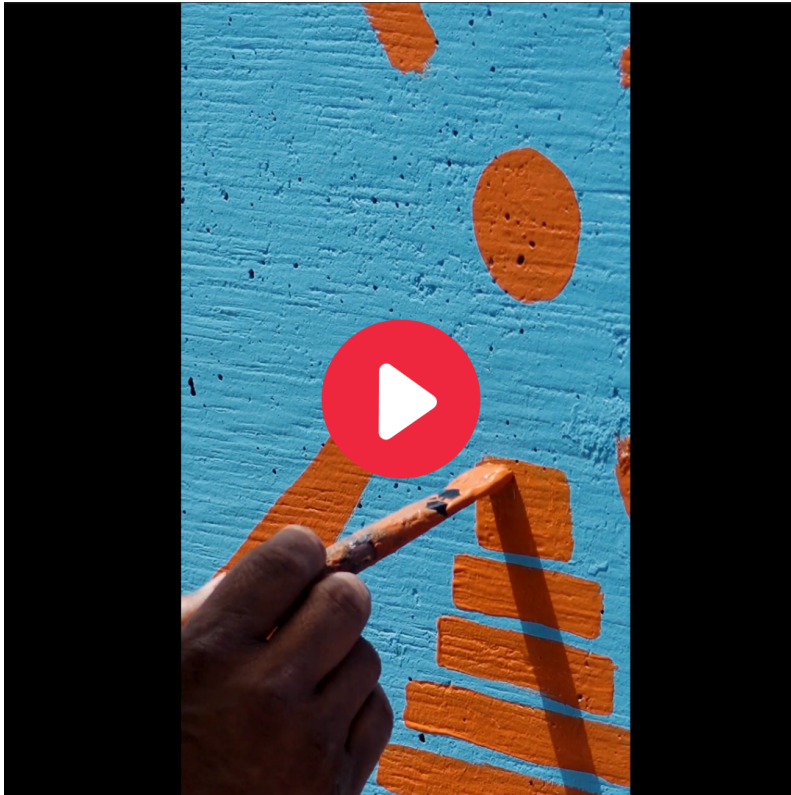
Good Luck Jazmine!
