Take Action



CFTA/CAA is mobilizing the field through a <u>sign on letter</u> to urge the California Arts Council (CAC) to reject several of the eligibility and grant program changes proposed by the CAC's Program Policy Committee.

In particular we are demanding that the CAC NOT limit grant eligibility to organizations with budgets under \$3 million, NOT limit State-Local Partner funding to organizations with budgets under \$1.5 million and NOT end the State and Regional Networks program as currently configured (visit our FundCAarts webpage for the committee report here and more info).

These proposed changes have been made without adequate input from the field, have the potential to destabilize critical programs and arts infrastructure in the state, and may pit members of the field against each other at a time when we need to unite to advocate for greater overall funding. We respect that the CAC is looking for ways to make arts funding in the state more equitable, but we don't believe these changes will help achieve these goals.


Program Spotlight: Arts Education


