This is the second exhibition for ArtWorks@Salinas. Curated and conceptualized by Deborah Good who also features in the presentation. "Inner Visions / Outward Expressions is the idea that artists are bringing forth their inner visions so that others can see and experience them," said Good. "This is the inner spirit where creativity is born and comes out", adds Kenji Tanner, featured artist, "then flourishes into the outer expression for others to see and see their own vision in my work." Reflecting on the exhibit pieces on display, Ekaterina de la Torre shares, "This work represents the invisible channels that intertwine and connect us."

The public is invited to see the exhibit at ArtWorks @Salinas located at 262 Main Street in Salinas, Thursdays through Sundays from 10 am – 2 pm in addition to special artist receptions coinciding with First Fridays in Downtown Salinas. The opening reception was held Friday, January 5 and will be followed by two more on Friday, February 2, and Friday, March 1st at 5 pm.
