Exhibition Juror

The Arts Council for Monterey County is seeking Monterey County residents from all supervisorial districts in the county, age 20 or older who are artists, art practitioners or part of the extended community to become exhibition jurors for our Fall 2026 exhibition program opportunities.

Arts4MC Exhibition Opportunities:

- Health Department Annual Exhibition
 - *Timeline for entries from mid-July to late August*
 - Entries shared with Exhibition Jurors - Monday, August 31st, 2026
 - Juror Decisions Due Monday, September 7th, 2026
- Government Center Annual Exhibition
 - *Timeline for entries from late July to early September*
 - Entries shared with Exhibition Jurors - Monday, September 7th, 2026
 - Juror Decisions Due Monday, September 14th, 2026

Jurors will make a ***One-Week*** commitment to review and rank 70-150 artwork submissions by the art review deadline. Jurors are asked to review images of submitted artworks and rate them. An average of 2-5 minutes is needed to appropriately review and rank each artwork submission.

Exhibition jurors will work independently ensuring an equitable, honest, and nuanced review and ranking process. The juror experience provides great insight into the juried exhibitions processes and can serve as a professional development practice for an individual's career and artistic goals. In addition to experienced arts practitioners, this is a great opportunity for new and emerging members of the arts and culture community.

As an appreciation for our exhibition jurors, individuals who complete their exhibition juror service will receive a \$100 honorarium per exhibition.
